

New rules of conduct regarding Corona virus Kitchen, Common rooms, Wet rooms

30th of October 2020



In general: Party ban - keep distance

- > Parties are no longer allowed (from the 19th of October on). Only groups smaller than 10 people can meet up in the general areas and common rooms of a building. You will have to wear a mask inside the buildings (except for the living rooms inside the shared flats) when it is impossible to keep the required distance.
- > The following still applies: Keep your distance, wash your hands regularly
- > The use of the SwissCovidApp is recommended



Shared kitchen/dining rooms

- > Masks are compulsory in larger shared kitchens and eating areas in households with 10 or more people (you can take the mask off when you are seated/eating)
- > Please comply with the markings in public dining rooms for designated individual dining areas in buildings with large shared kitchens
- > Clean the kitchen, used dining and kitchen utensils thoroughly after each use.
- > In the event of suspected infection, quarantine or confirmed illnesses: Do not enter the common kitchen and dining rooms

Common rooms

- > Common rooms are learning areas - be considerate, keep distance
- > You will have to wear a mask in the common rooms
- > Please air the room regularly and thoroughly

Wet rooms/sanitary facilities

- > After use, please also clean particularly thoroughly yourself
- > Do not leave toothbrushes and other personal items in the wet rooms



Self-isolation in case of infection / Quarantine after entry from risk areas

- > Tenants arriving from risk areas or with suspected infection, as well as those who are ill, must go into self-isolation and may only leave their room wearing a mask in exceptional cases.

- > In an event of suspected infection please call the hotline of canton Zürich (0800 33 66 55) and follow the instructions given by the staff

- > Please have understanding for tenants who are in self-isolation
- > Support sick people in self-isolation (in compliance with distance and hygiene measures)

- > During cleaning or repair work, the rooms are closed to tenants. Thorough cleaning is carried out.
- > Non-urgent repairs may not be carried out immediately.
